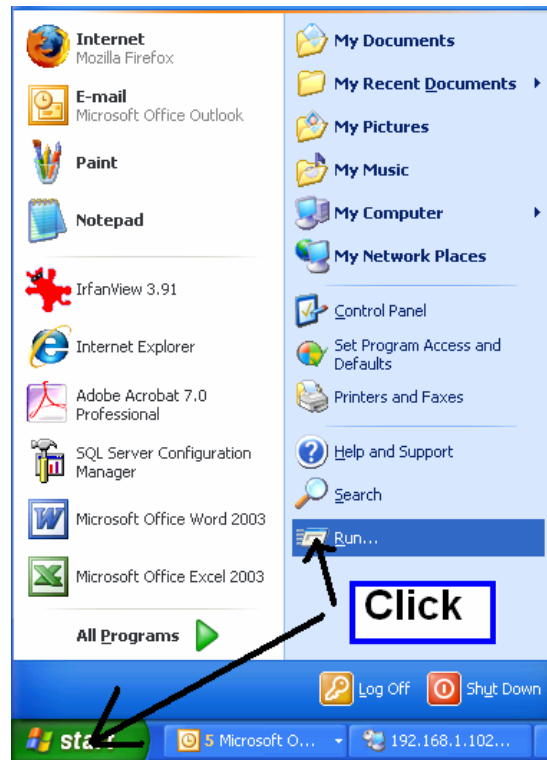
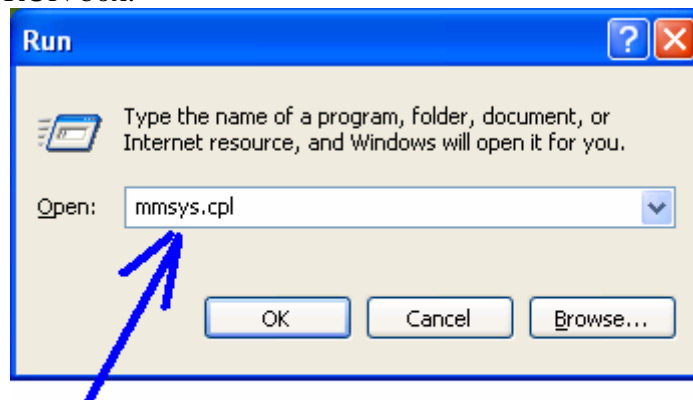


How to “unmute” the Microphone port in XP and Windows 2000.

1. Click on “Start” → “Run”



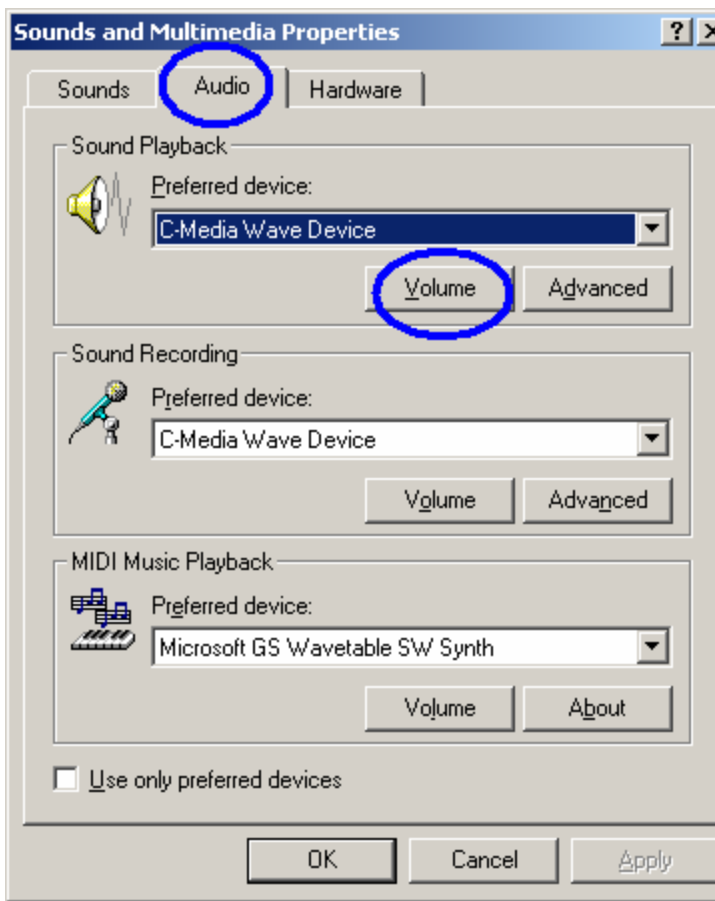
2. Type in mmsys.cpl in the RUN box.



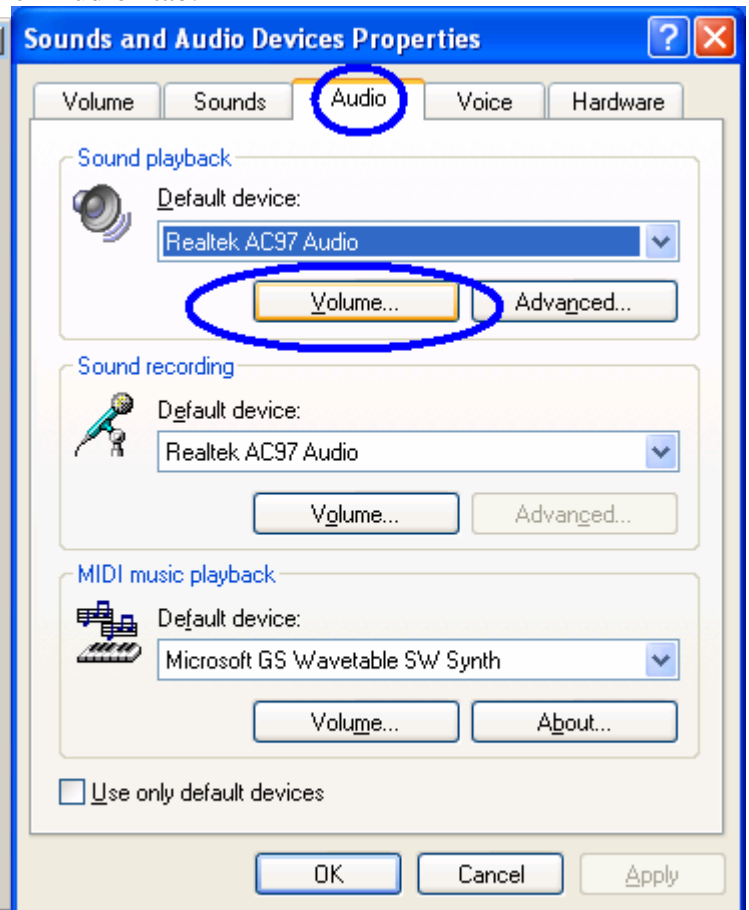
Type in mmsys.cpl

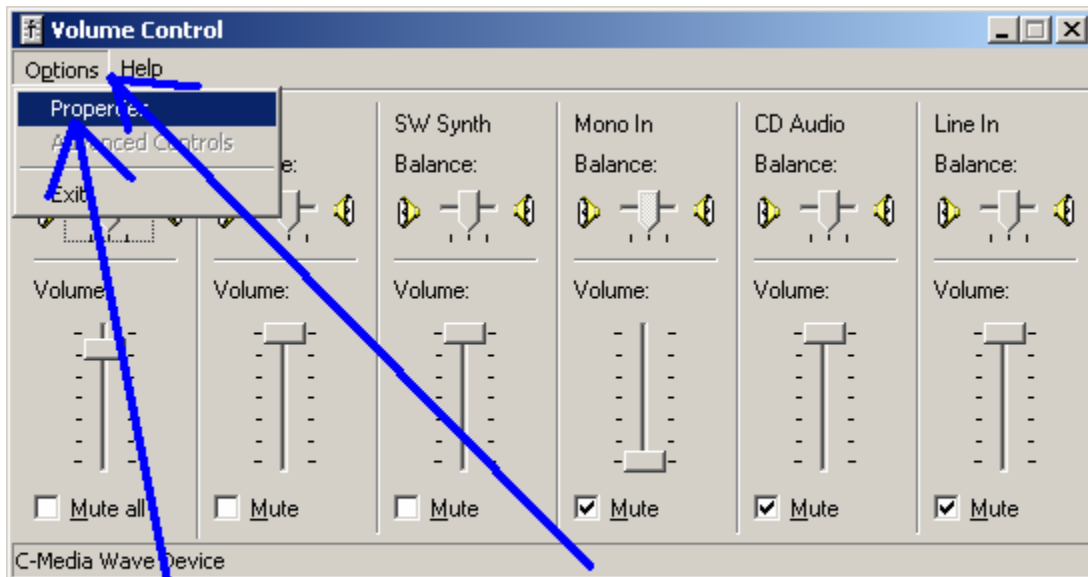
Windows 2000



Windows XP

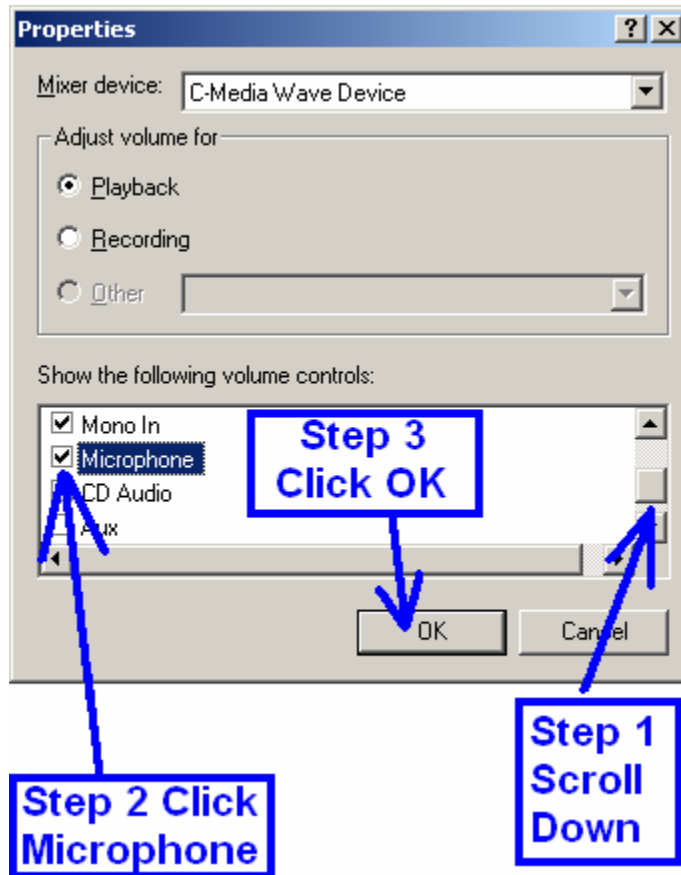
Click on the “Volume” button as shown.

4. Volume Control Panel.

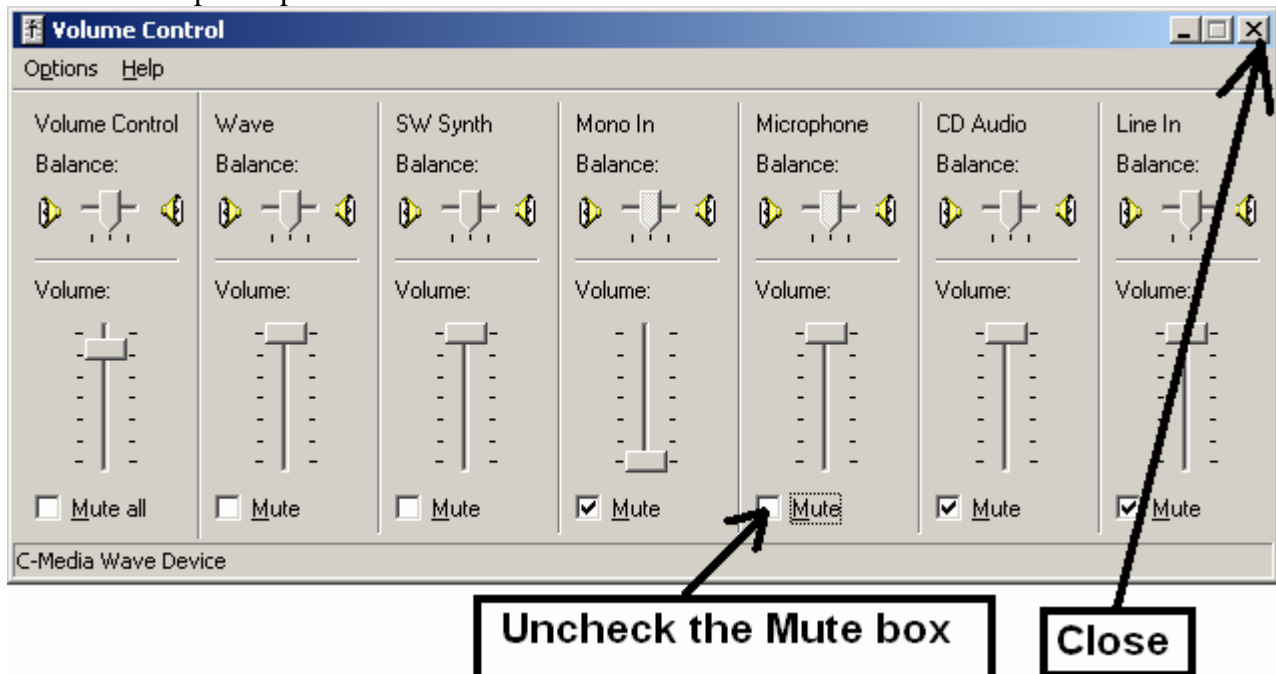


Click "Options" --> "Properties"
